1. Memon Jamat's Computer Training Center

As you all are aware through newsletter that we have been working to establish a computer training institute since couple of months and we have finally managed to have a very safe & excellent venue for the institute located at Sahafa Street, between Pakistani Embassy School and Indian Embassy Schools, Azizia Dist. **The framework of the institute is as follows:**

- 1. There will be 3 classes for one hour each for 3 days in a week (every alternate day).
- 2. Timings will be in the evening hours from 7 pm to 8 pm, 8 pm to 9 pm and 9 pm to 10 pm.
- 3. There will be **no training fees** for the individuals belong to memon community
- 4. Initially it will have basic computer courses, later on it will offer advance courses
- 5. Eligible for admission are:
 - A) Young boys, Students, adults, old age and retired gentlemen.
 - B) Young girls, students, housewives, old women,
- 6. Classes for male and female will be separate and on alternate days thrice a week.
- 7. It is purely welfare program of Memon Jamat who will bear all the expenses of the institute.

8. Opening of the institute is subject to positive feedback from the community.

MIRACLES OF THE WORD ALLAH!!
