

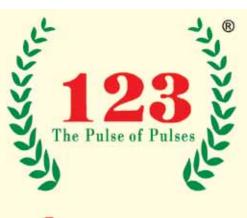



I was appointed as a General Secretary of Okhai Memon Youth Service in 1979 - this program provided the skills and confidence to be an effective social worker and counsellor. Moving on, I became the president of Okhai Memon Anjuman Girls Wing in 2000. I looked over the kids who were mentally and

physically challenged. My focus was entirely on the orphans and widows who needed moral support. The sole motive was to take them out of their deprived shell and make them understand their strengths. I feel proud to say that I was successful in providing them with good education and skills at minimum charges. Today these kids are capable of handling both household and education, which surely is an achievement for us. Currently, 300 girls are learning arts and crafts in the vocational activities which was offered complementary in the first three months, after that minimum charges were charged. Now I have a better understanding of the world of oppression and abuse as well as the hope, resilience, self-empowerment and the willingness to change and grow.

Moreover, I entered the World Memon Organisation in 2001 which was a huge platform and gave me a chance to serve the community in an even better way. Later, I handled its marriage bureau too. It was a great experience meeting different families and helping them. I used to take divorce cases too and I made sure



none of my clients leave my office with discontentment.

Presently, I am in charge of Okhai Memon Anjuman's marriage bureau and I work both in the office and in the house.

It's been an amazing journey and I absolutely love my work. It makes me internally happy when I see the destitute children smile. I believe everyone should be given the privilege and opportunity to unveil their true strengths and overcome their weaknesses. It's a beautiful life and everyone should live it to the fullest.

Team was organized by the membership Division of Ladies Wing on 17th March 2010 at the Sunset Club, Karachi. This seminar has conducted by torque (School of Leadership).

Objectives of Event:

- To bring together Networks of women from our Memon Community at one platform and motivate women endowed with talents, energy to devote their energies and time for social work and charity.
- To provide a forum for dialogue and discussion on issues of social welfare and culture.
- To promote awareness of issues relevant to ourselves and our community.
- To plan leisure activities activities for women enjoy themselves and meet others with similar interests.

It was a very interactive seminar and 104 ladies actively participated. It was fund and all the Ladies participated actively. 50% cost of the program was covered by Registration fees and 50% was paid by WMO.

The participants were divided in 10 groups and given the task to come up with different objectives. Evaluation form of the event were filled by the participants for survey. The women enjoyed the program and also showed keen interest in becoming

members of WMO.

2.WMO's Stall at SAARC Fair

The WMO Ladies Wing always tries hard to promote WMO as an international NGO. In this regard, a stall of WMO was setup by the WMO Ladies Wing at the fair Held by the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) on 6th March 2010 at the Marriot Hotel, Karachi. At this stall, pamphlets and CDs of WMO were distributed and the visions were briefed about WMO and its vision.

3.Flood Relief

Soon after the devastating floods all over Pakistan, Mrs. Amina Ganny (Vice Chairperson, Ladies Wing.) along with Mrs. Tabassum Abdul Qadir (Secretary, Ladies wing) took the initiative to go to

the most remote area of Kohistan. The valley wich was cut-off from the rest of the world because its 25 mile long road and the two bridges which connected it to the nearest town were swept away by the floods. Responding to the distress signals, the lady members took an alternate route crossing Babusar Pass (16,000 feet) and traveling down the Chilas valley to reach Kandian. In all, it was a grueling 20-hour journey over bumpy rods and gushing streams. This remote area is among the poorest in the country. Its people lead tough lives in difficult terrain which make them self-reliant and uncompromising on their basic needs. When we talked with them about the need to work together and in partnership, they responded with uncharacteristic warmth. Thereafter, food for more than 1000 people was distributed.

Later on, the ladies wing members also visited Flood Relief camps at Jamshoro and Razzakabad and distributed relief goods to about 300 families.

They also visited the Flood Relief camp at Gharo organized by WMO and Shaikhani Foundation, along with the other members of the Board of Management of WMO on 19 September.

Merey Angney Mein

The WMO Ladies Wing held its 1st Event of Mother and Daughters Gathering under title theme of "Merey Angney Mein" for matrimonial purpose. The Targeted audience were mother and eligible daughters and mothers of eligible sons.

The event at Royal Rodale, Defence Housing Authority, began with brunch and spanned 4 hours. After the brunch at restaurant, all participants were seated in





Banquet Hall. The program started with opening remarks by Mrs. Samreen followed by welcome speech by Chairperson, WMO Ladies wing, Mrs. Hawa Abdullah.

There was an icebreaking activity where participants were given different colors of ribbons and were shuffled to different tables having flags of their respective colors. This activity allowed them to have networking with other participants.

Next activity was "I AM" where own visiting card was made by each participants and the cards were rotated on the table they were sitting to know more about each other. Cards were than collected by volunteers the have data of all participants and for lucky draw. Thereafter a renowned singer Ms Asma Ahmed made all participants sing along with her.

After ever one two songs there was announcement of different categories of lucky draws. For example: any one having birthday in October. Any one wearing black dress with red purse. Any one wearing purple and many different categories.

The aim was to bring more and more participants on forefront. The program ended with lot of appreciation and demand for such events every 2 month. Self-Funding

achieves More (TEAM) was financed with two-thirds of the funds raised by donations and tickets while the remaining one-third was contributed by WMO Pakistan Chapter.

The expenses of the stall at the SAARC Fair were also taken care of by the members of the Ladies wing.

Activities & Events of WMO Ladies Wing during 2011

The WMO Ladies Wing has been actively engaged in collecting funds and relief goods for the Flood Relief Work in 2010 and 2011. So far, a considerable amount has been collected by the Ladies Wing besides donation in kind. Till date, an amount of Rs.1,627,500/- (US \$ 18,500)





Post humous Tributes Pride of Memon Achievers Awards 2014 by WMO Ladies Wing Pakistan Chapter

Hajiani Khadija Ma

Born in Bantva, Kathiawar in 1900 she came from a modest family. Despite having no formal education she undertook the mission of providing educational opportunities to Memon Girls.

Following the management of the madrassa at Akuli Mosque in Bantva, she formed a ladies forum by the name of 'Zanana Council' under which she started a madrassa 'Ziant ul Islam' Eventually it became the alma mater of 635 girls where they acquired religious education in Urdu and Gujrati and also learnt sewing.

After partition, with support from Ms. Fatima Jinnah, she started a girls' school in



Nankwada, Karachi called the 'Memon Girls School'. She also formed a Ladies Organization

in the name of 'Pakistan Memon Women Educational Society' which was forerunner of 'Raunaq-e- Islam Girls' Primary School'. Later she started another school in Federal B Area Karachi, and upgraded her schools to Secondary Level. She started a Girl's College in thickly populated area Mithadar-Kharadar.

Her efforts were acknowledged by Bantva Memon Jamat in 1978 when she was awarded a 10 tola Gold Medal, seventy five thousand rupees cash and many gifts in a grand ceremony. The gracious lady donated all this to the Jamat for the cause of female education and went home only with her Holy Quran, Tasbeeh and the prayer mat. She will be remembered as a pioneer of Memon Girls Education.



Marium Faruqi

Born in Pune in 1924, Marium, daughter of Sir Ibrahim, a well-known businessman, who also launched an Urdu weekly 'Muslim' and established a primary school in Haroon Hall in India before partition.

She studied Persian at college and did her undergraduate in Urdu and Persian. In Pakistan Maryam worked with Mrs Qazi Issa on the National Guard Movement in preparing young women for emergencies. She also worked with the Women's Muslim League.

Her passion for teaching started from the veranda of her home; with six tables and a few

chairs and led to the establishment of Happy Home School. Her spirit and enthusiasm is clearly reflected by the fact that despite her old age and failing health, she continued to lead the institution, vigorously climbing stairs and moving across corridors, only to make sure the school is functioning proper.

She was awarded Gold Medal from the University of Bombay for acquiring First Merit Position1945, Award of Fulbright Hayes Scholarship for Educational Administration and Supervision in the USA in 1960 - 6, President's Award for Literacy 1987, Award by Hamdard Naunehal Assembly 1988, Pakistan National Unity Award for her success in education by Pakistan

National Unity Council, Award for outstanding services for youth cause by Galaxy of Youth Pakistan 1997, Star Woman Award 1998 by Star Girls & Women Foundation, Prime Minister's Madar-e-Millat Award 2003, Lifetime Achievement Award by KFC 2007,

Fatimat-uz-Zohra Award 'For the Struggle she Initiated and her Commitment' by Working Women, Organization (Trust) Pakistan – 2007, Third Senior Citizen Award by Mera Ghar Welfare Association – 2008, Life time Achievement Award by the Directorate of Private School

Education 2009, Woman Educator of the Year Award by Pakistan Excellence Awards Foundation, Islamabad 2009, Life time Achievement Award by the Hamdard Foundation 2009, Lifetime Achievement Award by the Board of Intermediate Education Karachi 2010.

SherBano Katchi



During the 1980's she became the founder Vice President of Ladies Wing of the World Memon Foundation. She devoted her time and energy to the cause of uplift of Memon women in her role. Later when World Memon Organization was formed under the visionary leadership of ARY, she joined WMO and served as First Chairperson of Ladies Wing in Pakistan



She organized health campaigns, for making women aware of good nutrition and safety measures to avoid diseases. These campaigns also addressed medical problems faced by the children, and the elderly. She has also been promoting youth of the community through events, promoting employment and entrepreneurial opportunities.

She was honored by the Okhai Memon Jamaat. All Pakistan Memon foundation and WMO who have presented her shields in recognition of her endeavors.

She was an extraordinary entrepreneur besides, her family business she successfully ran her own silver jewelry business.



Laila Shahzada

Laila Shehzada amongst Pakistan's most internationally renowned artists. She studied with the Royal Drawing Society, London and was the first women painters in Pakistan to gain international recognition, with exhibitions around the world including Pakistan, London, Paris, Tokyo, Monte Carlo and New York. She was the first artist to draw inspiration from the archeological sites of the Indus valley and Taxila region. Laila played an important role in initiating and popularizing the ancient history of Pakistan by producing series of paintings which depicted the long lost civilization using its surviving artifacts.

Laila was honored in Pakistan by the President's Award, the Tamgha-e-Imtiaz in 1986 and the Pride of Performance in 1995, when she participated in a group show at the Shorouks International Gallery, Regent Street, London. She was the only Pakistani to be honored with the Key to the city of New York.

In the 1980s, she was selected to participate in an international display at the Westminster Gallery, London and her work was shown in an exhibition at the Barbican Gallery. On 14th August 2006, the Pakistan Post issued a Rs. 40 sheetlet of stamps to posthumously honor 10 Pakistani painters. Laila Shahzada is among those 10 painters.

Salwat Ali wrote a book on her by the name Laila Shehzda: Exploring an Inner Landscape produced by FOMMA-Foundation for Museum of Modern Art aimed at introducing outstanding contemporary artists and architects.

Aamena Ghani

Aamena was among the few Memon women who were lucky to receive higher education. Aamena got her higher education from Aligarh Muslim University. This university was founded by Sir Syed Ahmed Khan, who recognized the role of education in the empowerment of the poor and backward Muslim community.

Aamena was born in Bombay in the famous Mitha family. Her leadership qualities were evident from the very



beginning. During her education at the Aligarh University she remained very active and was the General Secretary of the Muslim Girls College Students Union. After her arrival to Pakistan she keenly participated in social service. Her contributions were noticed by the United Nations and she was sponsored to attend several conferences and seminars. In 1965 she was appointed as Director of Social Welfare Department by the Government of Pakistan. She was awarded a prestigious scholarship by the United Nations and went to New York for Community Development Training.

Bilquis Bano Edhi

Bilqis Bano Edhi is wife of Abdul Sattar Edhi, a humanitarian, a social worker

and one of the most active philanthropists in Pakistan. She was born in Karachi, where she joined the nurses training course at the Edhi Nurses Training Centre when she was in the 8th grade. Bilquis was one of the few Muslim girls there, because, at the time, nursing was not considered a suitable profession for a Muslim women. Nevertheless she was determined to become a nurse so she studied diligently, was passionate about her work and quickly became a first rank nurse.

She has been working with the Edhi Foundation – A Foundation which was started by Abdul Sattar Edhi with the mission to provide aid to Pakistan's poor and downtrodden, and has become Pakistan's major relief organization under the leadership of the husband and wife - team of Abdul Sattar and Bilquis Edhi. She heads the Bilquis Edhi

Foundation, holds the honor of being awarded the prestigious 'Hilal-e-Imtiaz', and with her husband received the '1986 Ramon Magsaysay Award for Public Service'. She is also the recipient of the 'Lenin Peace Prize'.

Her charity runs many services in Pakistan including a hospital and emergency service in Karachi. Edhi foundation is a major resource for assisting victims of disaster internationally. With all of the love and attention Bilquis gives the thousands of children rescued by the Edhi Foundation, this is why she is often called, 'The Mother of Pakistan'. She regularly visits Edhi Homes all over Pakistan to monitor their activities and give suggestions and recommendations on how she feels the work should be done. She is also instrumental in making Edhi Homes 'Centers of Excellence' – in the true sense of the word.

Dr. Zaitun Matcheswala

Dr. Zaitun Shah is the daughter of famous leader Haji Umar Ahmed Matcheswala, a close political associate of Quaid-e-Azam. She is a woman with immense brilliance and academic achievement that is unparalleled. She completed her PhD from St. Anthony's College, Oxford University. She was the only Asian lady who enjoyed the privilege of being the fellow of the Wolfson College at Oxford University and when the Islamic Culture Foundation was established in Oxford in 1971, she was appointed its Executive Director. It was dedicated towards promoting intercultural understanding by the publication of classical texts from Arabic, Persian, Turkish and Urdu. She worked as the General Editor of the series in which 76 authors and scholars worldwide participated.

She has written a book 'Life and Times of Sir Syed Ahmed Khan' which was published by Oxford University Press and a collection of her



poems tilted '99 Poems' has been published by Foundation for Islamic Culture.

She served as Professor and Advisor in Kuwait University, and also worked as the

advisor to Director of De-Colonization at the UN Institute of Training and Research Unit.

She returned to Pakistan at the invitation of Government of Pakistan and was appointed as the advisor to the Ministry of Finance and Economic Affairs Division. She simultaneously supervised the University Grants Commission, now HEC. She has also served as the advisor on Environmental Conservation and Education to Chamber of Commerce and has been the advisor in the committee for development of Educational Curriculum for Post Graduate Degrees in Baqai University.

She has organized the Karachi Stock Exchange Institute for Training and Research. She speaks on the Development of Women, Higher Education, Pollution and Environment and has been key note speaker at House of Lords for the Millennium Group on 'Empowering Women for Peace and Democracy' hosted by Women's Federation for World Peace. For aspiring young ladies of our community Dr. Zaitun is a role model.

Mariam Issa

A humanitarian and socialworker Mariam is a woman who has devoted most of her life to community service both in USA and Pakistan. She has served on several boards, Asian Pacific American Heritage as President, Asian American Coalition, Pakistan-Association of Greater Houston as President, Pakistan Association's Board of Trustee, Ancestral Film Festival, Blaffer Gallery, Express Theatre, Asia Society, Advisory board of UNICEF, Census 2000, Asia World Expo, as President of South Asian Chamber of Commerce and many more.

She founded the Pakistan-American

Volunteers Association to educate the American people about the rich heritage of Pakistan. The projects like March of Dimes, The Rehab Mission, the Asian Arts Festival and the Houston International Festival were among the achievements of this organization under the visionary leadership of Ms. Mariam Issa. She also raised funds for Red Cross Relief fund for September 11 and for the documentary movie; 'Muhammad; The Legacy of a Prophet'. This movie served immensely to diffuse the antagonistic views about Muslims in USA after 9/11 incidents. It was shown in 52 States of USA by PBS television stations.

She served as Vice President of Houston Mayoral Advisory Board for International-

Affairs and Development Asia and also Pakistani American Women's Association. Houston's Channel 11 honored her in Asia's selected program called 'Making History Today'.

She worked with Rotary Club

International installing 500 hand pumps in Sindh and Balochistan and was awarded the Paul Harris Fellow Award for this commendable achievement.

She was featured in the directory of

'Who's Who of Asian Americans' because of her accomplishments in the city of Houston. An avid political activist she campaigned for many political leaders out of which President Clinton, Hillary Clinton, Barack Obama etc.

Tara Uzra Dawood is a Canadian-Pakistani entrepreneur, money manager and freelance journalist. As CEO of Dawood Capital Management Ltd., she provides financial advice for individuals and corporate sector in Pakistan, and with her team she

facilitates financial security for women through her brainchild LADIES FUND and of children BABY FUND and CHILD FUND.

She is Editor-in-Chief of LADIES FUND Magazine, Pakistan's first magazine for women professionals and entrepreneurs. Tara is a strong advocate of educational opportunities and recently spearheaded the LADIES FUND Fellowships and Scholarships Programs. She founded, Dawood Global Foundation which is comprised of five wings: Investors and Supporters, Management, Brand Ambassadors, an Advisory Council, and a Student Advisory Board and Volunteers.

Tara was selected as Canada's Youth News Representative, which is the youth wing of the Associated Press. With her entrepreneurial savvy as a young journalist, Tara established a network of links with cosmetic labels, record labels and movie studios in Canada, the United States, and Europe. Tara has studied at Cornell University, Oxford University, and Harvard Law School with distinctions, and became a member of the New York Bar. Dr. Farzana is Pakistan's first visually impaired woman to acquire a Ph.D in Islamic Studies. Being a woman of immense moral strength, courage and determination she never let her blindness become her weakness.

After obtaining her B.A from St. Joseph's College in 1979, she completed her M.A in Philosophy Travelling to University of Karachi was a greater challenge, yet she continued her passion for education. In 1999 she did her Ph.D in Islamic Studies studying scholars like Shibli Nomani, Allama Muhammad Iqbal, Ghulam Ahmed Pervez and others. She is deeply impressed by Abul Ala Maududi and was fascinated by his writings since her childhood. Dr. Farzana



has done a certificate course in Arabic-Tadreesul Quran .

She has been teaching at the PECHS college for the past 20 years and imparting knowledge of Holy Quran to children. She

reads the Quran in Braille and has memorized many of its chapters. Further she converted the Syllabi, course materials and various Dictionaries into Braille so that blind students can be benefited. So far, she has converted more than 200 such material into Braille.

Dr. Farzana's achievements have been recognized and honored by the Rotary club, the All Pakistan Memon Federation, Aero Asia, Fanus (Narcotics) and many individuals. She has also been awarded Tamgha-e-Husn-e-Karkardagi by the Government of Pakistan.

Dr. Farzana is the President of Pakistan Braille Society and an active member of the Pakistan Association of Blind. She has presented many papers on Social Integration, Blind Women in Society etc..



Tabassum A Qadir

A woman with 'never-say-die' spirit, Tabassum A.Qadir, is presently the Managing Director of Pak Africa Aviation and currently pursuing her career in South Africa.

She started a textile exporting business at age of 22 from home under the guidance of her father in law. She than expanded the business in Africa and can be called the only woman entrepreneur of Pakistan who has travelled African countries like Uganda, Sudan, Angola, Zambia and Nigeria amongst other African countries.

This dynamic lady is amongst few women of Pakistan selected by United States for a leadership program. Her textile company provided a boost to Pakistan's exports and she won an award in Expo 2010 for Textile Exports.

With her travelling experience in Africa, she has now dared to enter the Aviation world and is currently busy launching an Airline in South Africa with a mission to connect Africa!

Pizza Hut at Muhammad Ali Society, Gelato Affairs etc.

Pakistan, though is a signatory to UN Convention On The Rights Of Persons With Disabilities, the disabled here are confined to their homes or go to special schools. Special people are not "Disable", they are "Differently Able" emphasizes Farhat.

Sidra is a prominent television broadcaster in Pakistan and has a number of signature shows, productions and momentous media appearances to her credit. Sidra became The First Pakistani Anchorperson to host the official digital platforms of the International Indian Film Awards 2012 (IIFA), the mega Bollywood extravaganza of immense global popularity in Singapore, a project that expanded Sidra's fans base across borders.

She is an entrepreneur and founder of Statuspro 360, one of Pakistan's foremost Integrated Brand Communications firms.

Currently NEED camps hold 63 families. Besides routine work and cases she also dealt and decided heinous cases like murder, Hudood cases, criminal, and civil, rent, family, guardianship, labour and banking cases. During her service she attended various courses, seminars, symposium, conferences, workshops. She was also nominated for colloquium for judges on the Enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights in Singapore.

She is also doing Ph.D. from University of Karachi and has taught law in Islamic Mission Women University Karachi. Her whole tenure shows that she played an active role in managing cases to ensure they proceed as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Hafiza Javeria Saleem

Javeria Saleem is famous for reciting Naat, as an anchor person and for her melodious Qariya-e-Quran in Pakistan. She was eight years old when she performed first time on Television on ARY QTV. She has performed on many national and international channels like PTV, Geo TV, ARY Digital, ARY QTV, Metro One, Hum TV, Shifa TV (USA), Noor TV (UK) and has been interviewed in many national and international Newspapers and Magazines.

She has been acknowledged throughout the Islamic world for her melodic and spell-



binding recitations that poetically praise Allah and his beloved Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W). She won 'All Pakistan Naat Competition' in 2004 organized by QTV. Farzana Munaf

Farzana Munaf is a Woman of Action who became Chief Financial Officer in an Investment Committees and has served in the Board of Directors with an overall responsibility of Finance Department in Pakistan Reinsurance Company Limited.

She was awarded with a Gold Medal for her position in ICAP as the First Female student in Pakistan to secure this position. She has been associated with renowned firms like Ford, Rhodes, Robson, Morrow (FRRM), Pakland Group, National Invest Trust Limited, First Women Bank Limited and House Building Finance Corporation



and has almost 24 years of experience. She was a part of IBA as Director Finance and

has delivered lectures to students of Benazir Bhutto Shaheed Youth Development Program (BBSYDP). She has presented technical papers in ICAP seminars and has conducted lectures for many years on auditing and accounting for ICAP students. Through this platform she served the community by distributing medicines and arranging numerous free medical camps in nearly 100 slum areas of Karachi.





હબીબ વલીમોહંમદે ગાચેલા બિન ફિલ્મી ગીતોમાં વતનપ્રેમના ગીતો 'એ નિગારે વતન તું સલામત રહે, રોશન રખ્શાં-નેચરો તાબાં, સોહની ધરતી-અલ્લાહ રખ્ખે વગેરે ભારે લોકપ્રિય થયા હતા.

હબીબ વલીમોહંમદે ગાયનના પોતાના શોખને વ્યવસાય બનાવ્યો નહોતો. એ પોતે ખમતીધર ઉદ્યોગપતિ પરિવારના હતા અને તેમણે કરાચીમાં શાલીમાર સિલ્ક મિલ્સની સ્થાપના કરી હતી જેમાં તેમણે અમેરિકામાં કરેલા એમબીએના ભણતરથી મળેલા જ્ઞાનનો ઉપયોગ કર્યોં હતો. ઉદ્યોગ ક્ષેત્રે પણ તેમણે કામ્યાબી મેળવી હતી. તેમના મોટાભાઈ અશરફ વલીમોહંમદ તબાણી પણ ટોચના ઉદ્યોગપતિ હતા અને બાદમાં રાજકારણમાં પ્રવેશીને થોડા સમય સિંધના ગવર્નંટ પણ રહ્યા હતા.

પાકિસ્તાનમાં ગીત–ગઝલો ગાઈને નામના કમાવ્યા બાદ હબીબ વલીમોહંમદ અમેરિકામાં જઈ વસ્થા હતા. ત્થાં પણ તેઓ ગઝલો ગાવાના શોખને ખાનગી મેહકીલોમાં ગાઈને นโซสเ રહ્યા édi. અમેરિકા–કેનેડામાં વિવિદા મેહકીલોમાં અને આઝાદી દિન જેવા પસંગોએ ચોજાતા સમારંભોમાં પણ હળીબ વલીમોહંમદને આગ્રહ સાથે નોતરવામાં आवता édi. અમેરિકામાં જ કેલિકોર્નિંચા મકામે તેમનો ૮૪ વર્ષની પાકટ વચે ચોથી સપ્ટેમ્બર ૨૦૧૪ના રોજ ઈન્તેકાલ થતાં તેમના ચાહકોમાં શોક વ્યાપી ാലി രപി.

હબીબ વલીમોહંમદ આજે આપણી વચ્ચે નથી, પણ તેમની અમર ગઝલો હંમેશા એ મેમણ વીરલાની ચાદ અપાવતી રહેશે.

પ્રકારોમાં ટેસ્ટ ક્રિકેટ સોથી જૂની પ્રણાલી છે. એક મેચમાં ચાર ઈનીંગ હોચ તો તેને ટેસ્ટ ક્રિકેટ કહેવાચ છે જે પાંચ દિવસ સુધી રમવાનો નિચમ શરૂઆતથી જ ઘડાચેલો છે. પહેલી સત્તાવાર ટેસ્ટ મેચ ૧૫મી માર્ચ ૧૮૭૭ના રોજ મેલબોર્નના ક્રિકેટ ગ્રાઉન્ડમાં ઓસ્ટ્રેલીચા અને ઈંગ્લેન્ડ વચ્ચે રમાઈ હતી. ઓસ્ટ્રેલીચાએ એ મેચ ૪૫ રનથી જીતી લીધી હતી.

વન-ડે ઇન્ટરને શનલ ક્રિકેટનો આરંભ ર૦મી સદીમાં થયો હતો. શરૂમાાં તેને લિમીટેડ ઓવર્સ ક્રિકેટ અને લિમીટેડ ઓવર્સ ઇન્ટરનેશનલ જેવા નામ અપાયા હતા. વર્લ્ડ કપની મેચો વન-ડેના ધોરણે રમવામાં આવે છે. પહેલી વન-ડે ઇન્ટરનેશનલ મેચ પાંચમી જાન્યુઆરી ૧૯૭૧ના દિવસે ઓસ્ટ્રેલીયા અને ઇંગ્લેન્ડ વચ્ચે રમાઈ હતી અને એ મેચ પણ ઓસ્ટ્રેલીચાએ પાંચ વિકેટથી જીતી લીધી હતી. વન-ડે ઈન્ટરનેશનલ મેચ પણ સફેદ રંગની કીટસ અને લાલ રંગના બોલથી રમવાની પ્રથા વરસો સુધી ચાલતી રહી હતી.

એ પછી કેરી પેકરે ૧૯૭૦ના દાચકામાં વર્લ્ડ ક્રિકેટ સીરીઝ ક્રિકેટ દુર્નામેન્ટનો આરંભ કર્યો અને વન-ડે ક્રિકેટમાં રંગીન ચુનિફોર્મ, રંગીન બોલ અને કે એન્ડ નાઈટ મેચોનો ચીલો પડયો. બાદમાં લિમીટેડ ઓવરની મેચોને ૨૦ ઓવરની મેચમાં પલટી દેવાઈ જે આજે ટી-ટવેન્ટીના નામે લોકપિય છે. પાછલી સદીના ક્રિકેટની સરખામણીમાં આજનું ક્રિકેટ દેખીતી રીતે વધુ નવીનતાભર્યું અને વધુ ઝડપી છે, પણ જૂના શોખીનો કહે છે કે નવા ક્રિકેટમાં જૂના ક્રિકેટ જેવું શિસ્ત, જોમ કે સ્પોટર્સમેન સ્પીરીટનો અભાવ વર્તાંઇ આવે છે. ચેમ્પિયનશીપની રચના પણ ઈંગ્લેન્ડમાં ૧૮૯૦માં થઈ હતી જેનું પુનરાવર્તન ૧૮૯૨માં ઓસ્ટ્રેલીયામાં કરાયું હતું અને ન્યુઝીલેન્ડ, સાઉથ આફ્રિકા તથા ઈન્ડિયાની રણજી ટોફીની ટીમો તેમાં શામેલ હતી.

રસિક વાત એ છે કે ૧૮૯૦માં એક ઓવરમાં માત્ર ચાર બોલ કરાતા હતા જે બાદમાં વધીને પાંચ બોલની ઓવર કરાઈ હતી અને છ બોલની ઓવરની વર્તમાન પ્રણાલી ઈસવી чеооні นรใ ക്പി सत ઓસ્ટ્રેલીયાએ ૧૯૨૨માં આઠ બોલની ઓવર રાખવાનો અખતરો કરી જોયો હતો. છેક ૧૯૪૭ના ક્રિકેટના કાયદા સુધી એક ઓવરમાં મેચના સંજોગો અનુસાર છ થી આઠ બોલ ફેંકવાની છૂટ રખાઈ હતી. ક્રિકેટના ખેલની વ્યવસ્થા માટે १८०८मां ईन्टरनेशनल क्रिडेट કાઉન્સિલની સ્થાપના કરાઈ હતી. ઈમ્પિરીયલ ક્રિકેટ કોન્કરન્સ. ઓસ્ટ્રેલીયા, સાઉથ આફ્રિકા અને ઈંગ્લેન્ડ તેની સ્થાપક ટીમો હતી. આ સંસ્થાનં नाभ aesuni ઈન્ટરનેશનલ ક્રિકેટ કોન્કરન્સ કરી દેવાયું હતું પણ ૧૯૮૯માં તેને કરીવાર ઈન્ટરનેશનલ ક્રિકેટ કાઉન્સિલ કરી દેવાઈ હતી. તમામ ઈન્ટરનેશનલ ક્રિકેટ મેચોની વ્યવસ્થા આ કાઉન્સિલને સોંપાયેલી

'ક્રેકેટ' હતું. ડચ ભાષામાં તેનો અર્થ 'લાકડી' થાય છે. છોકરાઓની આવી રમત જોયા બાદ પુખ્તવયના લોકોએ ઈસવી સન ૧૬૧૧માં ક્રિકેટ રમવાનું શરૂ કર્યું હતું. જો કે એ જમાનામાં ક્રિકેટ ટરોનો ચર્ચમાં જવાને બદલે ક્રિકેટ રમવામાં મશગુલ રહેલા બે પુરૂષોને સજા કરવામાં આવી હતી. ૧૮મી સદી અગાઉ ક્રિકેટની રમત માત્ર ગામડાના ખેલ તરીકે રમાતી રહી ഭദി. ભાદમાં નોર્થ ઈંગ્લેન્ડમાં

ક્રિકેટનો ખેલ ધીમે ધીમે લોકપ્રિય થવા માંડ્યો હતો અને ૧૭મી સદીના અંત ભાગમાં ઈંગ્લેન્ડની કોલોનીઓ મારફત ક્રિકેટનો ખેલ નોર્થ અમેરિકા સુધી ફેલાઈ ગયો હતો. ૧૮મી સદીમાં ઈસ્ટ ઈન્ડિયા કંપની મારકત ક્રિકેટ વેસ્ટ ઈન્ડીઝ તથા ઈન્ડિયામાં પહોંચ્યું હતું. ૧૮૭૭માં ઓસ્ટ્રેલીયામાં અને



પૂરા વિસ્તારની આ ৷ થિંદ ખુશહાલીના આ પ્રસ્તાવને અમલી દ્યોરણે പടഗ બનાવવા માટે આ વિસ્તારના

ઈતિહાસને સમજવાની અને એક વ્યવસ્થિત વ્યૂહ રચવાની જરૂરત છે, જે છેવટે કરાચી અને મુંબઇ (મહારાષ્ટ્રમાં હોવા છતાં)ને જોડી શકે છે. ત્રણે રાજચોના મુખ્ય પ્રધાનો શ્રીમતી વસુંધરા રાજે, શ્રીમતી આનંદીબેન પટેલ અને સૈચદ કાઈમઅલી શાહ વેપારીઓ. આગેવાન રાજનેતાઓ અને વિવિધ ક્ષેત્રોના નિષ્ણાંતોને લઈને કોઈ એક જગાઓ ലഗി લે એ aì મુનાબાઓ-ખોખરાપાળના સંપર્ક રૂટનો ભરપૂર લાભ તેમજ ગુજરાત-રાજસ્થાનને સિંધ સાથે જોડવાનો વ્યૂહ ઘડાઈ શકે છે અને *અજરક કોરીડોર*ની રચના થઈ શકે કરે.

અત્યારે તો ભારત અને

પાકિસ્તાનના વેપારીઓ કે સરકારી અધિકારીઓ જયારે પણ મળે છે ત્યારે સો પ્રથમ તો મોસ્ટ કેવર્ડ નેશન (સૌથી માનીતા દેશ)નો દરજજો આપવા અથવા તો ભારતથી વાઘા સરહદ મારકત અત્યારની ૧૩૭ આચરમોની મર્ચાંદા ખતમ કરવા પર જ વધુ ધ્યાન આપે છે. જયારે કે મુનાબાવ-ખોખરાપાળ રૂટના વિકાસ થર એકસપ્રેસ ટ્રેનની અવરજવર વધારવા, ખોખરાપાળ સરહદથી ટકોની આવ-જા માટે ચેકપોસ્ટ સ્થાપવા કે મુંબઈ અને કરાચીમાં ડેપ્યુટી હાઈકમિશનો ખોલવા જેવા મૂળભૂત મામલાઓ પર ભાગ્યે જ વાત કરાચ છે. ટૂંકમાં કહીએં તો 'અજરક કોરીડોર'ની અવગણના કરાઈ રહી છે.

પશ્ચિમ પંજાબ અને પૂર્વ પંજાબ વચ્ચે સંબંધો ગાઢ બનાવવાની પ્રવૃત્તિઓમાં તાજેતરના દિવસોમાં જબરો વધારો દેખાયો છે અને વાઘા–અટારી સરહદે સારી સગવડોને પ્રતાપે માલ-સામાન અને લોકોની અવર-જવર સરળ બનાવાઈ છે. બીજા તરક બલોચિસ્તાન અને સિંદાના શહેરીઓ આવી પ્રવૃત્તિઓથી વંચિત છે. જો કે એક જમાનામાં પાકિસ્તાનથી ભારત ખાતેની ૭૫ ટકા निકास तेमक लारतथी ४० टडा આચાત સિંધ-રાજસ્થાન ૩ટ મારકત થતી હતી. અત્યારે તો દસ્તાવેજો વગરના માલની હેરાકેરી સિવાય આ રૂટ પર કોઈ અધિકૃત વેપાર થઈ રહ્યો નથી. રૂટનો ઉપયોગ કરાય તો અનેકગણો લાભ થઈ શકે છે જેમાં તબીબી સારવાર, મઝહબી સ્થળોની મુલાકાતો અને તાલીમી કેન્દ્રો સુધી પહોંચની સફર,

જમાનામાં વેપાર, સંસ્કૃત્તિ, નવા નવા સુધારા અને રૂહાની માર્ગદર્શનનો ગઢ રહી ચૂકયો છે. અત્થારે ભારતના બે રાજ્યો ગુજરાત અને રાજસ્થાન तथा पाडिस्ताननुं सिंध सरहही દ્યોરણે જાદા ભલે પડી ગયા હોય. પણ તેમનામાં ઉપરોક્ત સમાનતાઓ આજે પણ મોજુદ છે, જેને વેપાર-ધંધા અને સંસ્કૃત્તિના વિશાળ દામ અને લોકો વચ્ચે મેળ -भिलापना डेन्द्रमां पलटाववी જોઈએ. આ ધ્યેય હાસિલ કરવા માટે જયપુર, ગાંધીનગર અને કરાચીમાં એકીસાથે હેતુપૂર્ણ પગલાં શરૂ કરવા જોઈએ. આ રીતે રચાતા સમાન મથકને *'અજરક–કોરીડોર'*નું નામ આપી શકાય. પુરૂષો ખભા પર રાખે છે એ ખેસ કે અજરક તરીકે

તેલ-ગેસ અને કોલસાનો કારોબાર, ટેક્નીકલ નિપૂણતાના વિકાસ, હસ્ત ઉદ્યોગ અને કપડા ઉદ્યોગ જેવા અનેક ક્ષેત્રોના વિકાસ જેવા ફાયદા શામેલ છે. આ રીતે અજરક કોરીડોર જરૂરી ઠરે છે.

જે લોકોના કુટુંબો કે સગા-સંબંધીઓ સરહદ પાર છે એવા ખાસ કરીને ગુજરાત-રાજસ્થાન અને સિંધના શહેરીઓને અત્યારે ಕಡಿಕ પ રિસ્થિતિનો છે. સામનો રાજસ્થાનના જોધપુર અને સિંધના ઉમરકોટ વચ્ચેના ૪૦૦ કિલોમીટર જેટલા 'ઘાટ' વિસ્તારમાં વસતા લોકો રિવાયતી, મઝહબી, સામાજિક અને નસલી બંધનોથી બંધાચેલા છે. ૧૯૬૫માં ચુદ્ધ પછીથી પ્રતિબંધ મુકાતાં આ લોકોની સરહદની આરપાર આવ-જા અવરોદ્યાઈ ગઈ છે *અજરક કોરીડોર*થી આ લોકોની મુશ્કેલીઓ સરળ થઈ શકે છે.

સિંધ અને ગુજરાત વચ્ચેની સરહદ પરની પરિસ્થિતિ પણ હતાશાજનક છે. પહેલાંના જમાનામાં I KS പ്പ് રાજચો વરશે માલ-સામાનની સારી એવી અવરજવર રહેતી હતી. મેમણ, ખોજા, બોહરી અને વ્હોરા જેવી નસલી વેપારી બિરાદરીઓ અહીં વેપાર-ઉદ્યોગમાં નોંધપાત્ર સ્થાન ધરાવે છે. સિંધમાં કરાચી ઉપરાંત આંતરિક સિંધના બીજા કેટલાક શહેરીમાં આ બિરાદરીઓ મોજાદ છે. આ લોકો ફળદ્રુપ સંપત્તિ સમાન છે. જેમનો અજરક કોરીડોરમાં વ્યાપાર અને મૂકીરોકાણના વિકાસમાં ઉપયોગ થઈ શકે છે.

વાદ્યા-અટારી રૂટ પર માલ-સામાન અને લોકોની અવર-જવર પર અંકુશ અને નિગરાની સરળતાથી ચાલી રહી હોવાથી ભાત અને પાકિસ્તાન વચ્ચે વ્યવહારનો બીજો કોઈ માર્ગ ખોલવા સામે જોરદાર વાંધો લેવાતો રહ્યો છે. એવી ગેરસમજ ફેલાચેલી છે કે રાજસ્થાન-સિંધ-ગુજરાત રૂટ ખોલવાથી ભારતી માલની આચાત બેકામ બની જશે અને લોકોની અને ખાસ કરીને સિંધના હિંદુઓ તેમજ ૧૯૪૭માં ભાગલાં સમયે ભારતથી પાકિસ્તાન આવેલા શહેરીઓની આવ-જા નિચંત્રણમાં નહીં રહે. સિંધ અને ગુજરાત વચ્ચે તો આજે પણ સડક, રેલ્વે કે હવાઈ માર્ગે કોઈ સીધો સંપર્ક નથી. આ બંને રાજયોના મહત્વના શહેરોને સડકોના નેટવર્કથી જોડીને તેને રાજસ્થાન સધી વિસ્તારી શકાય છે જેનાથી માલ અને લોકોની અવર-જવર ઝડપી અને સરળ બની જશે. મુનાબાઉ-ખોખરાપાળ રેલ્વે લાઈનને ગુજરાત સુધી સ્હેલાઈથી લંબાવી શકાય છે. વહાણવટાના કોઈ સીધા સંપર્કનો અભાવ પણ વેપાર આડેની એક મોટી રકાવટ છે. પાકિસ્તાનથી જેટલો માલ ભારત ખાતે નિકાસ થાય છે એનાથી વધ્ માલ ત્યાંથી આચાત થતો હોવાથી બંને દેશોની સરકારોએ ભારતી શીપીંગ લાઈનને સિંદના કરાચી બંદર અથવા પોર્ટ કાસિમ તથા ગુજરાતના કંડલા કે મુંદ્રા બંદરો વચ્ચે જહાજી સર્વિંસ શરૂ કરવાની છુટ દેવી જોઈએ. આવી મોટી પહેલ *અજરક* કોરીકોરની અગત્થતા વધારી શકે છે.

ગુજરાતી શખ્સ નરેન્દ્ર મોદીની ચૂંટણીને ગુજરાત અને સિંધ વચ્ચે રિવાયતી સંબંધોના પુનઃજન્મ તરીકે જોવામાં આવી રહી છે. સખત નિવેદનો છતાં એક નવી શરૂઆત થવાની તેમજ ગુજરાત-રાજસ્થાનની નેતાગીરી તેમના સિંધી સમોવડીયા નેતાઓ સાથે રાજદૂતીય સંબંધોના મહત્વને સ્વિકારે એવી આશા રાખી શકાય છે. આ ત્રણે રાજયોની વેપારી બિરાદરીનો ટેકો અને સહયોગની तत्परता એક प्रोत्साहड जाजत छे અને ખાસ અગત્થની વાત તો એ છે કે તેમની વચ્ચેનો સુમેળ પૂરા ഭിടിം વિસ્તારમાં રહેતા ખુશહાલીના પ્રચાસોમાં પૂરક બની શકે છે. અજરક કોરીકોરની કામ્યાબીનો આ સાર છે.

અમદાવાદ હાલાઈ મેમણ જમાતનો વિદ્યાર્થી સન્માન સમારંભ

રવિવાર ૭ સપ્ટેમ્બરના રોજ હાલાઈ મેમણ મોટી જમાત, અમદાવાદ તરફથી વિદ્યાર્થી સન્માન સમારંભનું પાલડી સ્થિત ટાગોર હોલમાં આયોજન કરાયું હતું. ઓલ ઈન્ડિયા મેમન જમાત ફેડરેશનના ઉપપ્રમુખ જનાબ ઈકબાલ મેમણ ઓફિસર તથા આઈસીએઆઈની અમદાવાદ શાખાના અધ્યક્ષ શ્રી નિકેતન તલાટી (ચાર્ટર્ડ એકાઉન્ટન્ટ) આ સમારંભમાં મુખ્ય મહેમાનો તરીકે હાજર રહ્યા હતા.

બપોરે ૩.૦૦ કલાકે તિલાવતે કલામે પાક સાથે કાર્યંક્રમની શરૂઆત થઈ હતી. અમદાવાદ જમાતના પ્રમુખ મુહમ્મદ શરીફ નૂર મુહમ્મદ મેમણે સ્વાગત પ્રવચનમાં મહેમાનોનો પરિચય કરાવ્યો હતો તથા અમદાવાદની જમાતની કામગીરીનો અહેવાલ રજૂ કર્યોં હતો. તેમણે વધ્ માહિતી આપતાં જણાવ્યું હતું કે તેઓ વર્ષ ૨૦૦૨ થી ૨૦૦૬ સુધી જમાતના પ્રમુખપદે હતા તે દરમિયાન જમાતખાના (डोम्युनिटी सेन्टर)नुं મેમણોની ભરચક વસતિ ધરાવતા દાણી લીમડા ખાતે નિર્માણ કરવા માટે જમીન ખરીદવામાં આવી હતી. વર્ષ ૨૦૧૩માં તેઓ ફરી પ્રમુખપદે ચુંટાઈ આવ્યા બાદ કોમ્યુનિટી સેન્ટરના નિર્માણ માટેની પ્રવૃત્તિઓને વેગ અપાયો હતો. 3પિયા ૬૦ થી ૭૦ લાખના ખર્ચે આ સેન્ટર આકાર પામી રહ્યું છે અને આગામી ત્રણ ચાર માસમાં બાંધકામ પરિપૂર્ણ થઈ જશે.

તેમણે વધુમાં જણાવ્યું હતું કે વર્ષ ૨૦૧૦માં જરૂરતમંદો માટે મકાનોની કોલોનીનું નિર્માણ કર્યું હતું અને આ મોટી કામગીરીમાં જનાબ ઈસ્માઈલભાઈ કેજીએનવાલાનો બહોળો સહકાર સાંપડયો હતો. હાલ આ કોલોની જયાં આવેલી છે તે જમીન પર જ વધુ બાવન મકાનોનું નિર્માણ કરવાનું આચોજન કરાયું છે અને આ મકાનો જરૂરતમંદોને ફાળ વાશે.

જમાતના ૧૬૦૦ સભ્યોને આવરી લેતી એસએમએસની વ્યવસ્થા શરૂ કરાઈ છે, જે હેઠળ સુખ–દુઃખના પ્રસંગો વિષે તમામ સભ્યોને તરત જ વાકેફ કરાય છે.
