AGM Highlights

WMO

- WMO's role to be extended from that of merely a Zakaat collector and distributor to a more inclusive role, aiming to connect and strengthen the global Memon community.
- Changes to the structure of WMO, as well as amendments to the Constitution and Standing Orders of the WMO and WMO CF in order to ensure a more robust and transparent organization
- The President and senior officials of the WMO and WMO CF to make an annual tour to all WMO Chapters.
- A renewed focus on education.
- The distribution of Zakaat to be conducted among all Chapters.

Chapters

- The North America Chapter to be revived, kicking off with a Road Show to welcome the Memon Community of North America back into the WMO family.
- The African Chapter to be divided into two separate Chapters, the Southern Africa Chapter and the Northern Africa Chapter.
- The Southern Africa Chapter will establish its own Memon Centre, as well as explore the possibility of establishing a Vocational Training Institute, similar to the MITI in Pakistan.
- The European and Far East Chapters will strive to expand the WMO's reach across the relevant regions.
- A permanent office is to be set up for the Indian Chapter.

General

- Launch of 'Children with Special Needs' project, and announcement of the winner of the Logo Competition.
- 'Memon Connection' a WMO social initiative to connect Memons from around the globe and help them find life partners, was formally introduced.
- The launch of 'Memon Premier League'- a T20 Indian IPL style cricket tournament, to be played by teams from each Chapter. The MPL will be hosted in Sri Lanka by the Far East Chapter.
- Proposed launch of an International Youth Forum, aiming to encourage the younger generation to become more actively involved in WMO activities.

Five months of tears and sleepless nights have finally come to an end for headline making 3-year-old burn victim Isabella Kruger, from Pretoria, South Africa. Isabella suffered horrific burns over three quarters of her body during a New Year's Eve mishap and has been suffering ever since.

Now, thanks to renowned plastic surgeon Dr. Ridwan Mia (son of Mr. S.H. Mia – trustee of the World Memon Organization) there is an end in sight to her nightmare.

Dr. Mia performed a skin graft operation on the toddler using a revolutionary technology known as Epicel – which produces skin for people with extensive burn wounds by extracting stem cells from small patches of patients' healthy skin.
